SUMMER EMPLOYMENT

WORK PERIOD – JUNE 29th to AUGUST 22nd, 2010

HEAD COOK – Mature, self-motivated individual. Must be able to prepare food in an efficient, timely manner following a set menu for 50 – 80 persons, 3 meals per day. Preference will be given to persons with two or more year's experience. Salary range: \$450 - \$550 per week.

ASSISTANT COOK (2 Positions) – Self-motivated person who can work with minimum supervision. As part of a team, you must be able to prepare food in an efficient, timely manner under the direction of the Head Cook. On the job training provided. Minimum age 18 preferred. Salary range: \$375 - \$475 per week.

WATERFRONT SUPERVISOR – Ontario Ministry of Health standards required. NLS, First Aid, Level 3 Flatwater canoe course or better, and Watercraft qualifications. Minimum age 18 required. Successful applicant will be in charge of all water-related activities and must be prepared to work in a team environment. Salary range: \$450 - \$550 per week.

ASSISTANT WATERFRONT – Successful applicants must have his/her NLS, First Aid, Level 3 Flatwater canoe course or better, Watercraft qualifications and be able to work under the direction of the Waterfront Supervisor. Successful applicant must be prepared to work in a team environment. Minimum age 18 required. Salary range: \$375 - \$475 per week.

FLOATER – Lifeguard / Kitchen Assistant / Caretaker. Successful candidate will be required to act as floater between all jobs at Camp as needs arise. Applicants must have his/her NLS, Watercraft qualifications and first aid preferred. He/she must take responsibility for all aspects of Tuck. Successful applicant must be prepared to work in a team environment. Minimum age 17 required. Salary range: \$375 - \$475 per week.

CARETAKER/JANITOR – A mature self-motivated person required to maintain the site to the Ontario Ministry of Health standards. Washrooms and kitchen must be cleaned and sanitized daily and other duties performed as required. Individual must have his/her Watercraft qualifications. Knowledge of some repairs an asset. Retired persons welcomed. Successful applicant must be prepared to work in a team environment. Salary range: \$350 - \$450 per week.

COUNSELLORS – 12 part time positions. Successful applicants will work in one week intervals for four to five weeks throughout the summer. Applicants must be enthusiastic and responsible team players who will provide fun and leadership for campers. Counsellors will live in cabins with campers and lead campers in the daily activities of summer camp. Leadership training, lifeguarding and canoeing qualifications, and previous camp counseling experience are assets. Minimum age 16 required. Salary: \$200 - \$250 per week.
